# AGOSTINO BOSCO

## Barolo - La Morra | Piedmont

A small family winery founded by Pietro Bosco (1904 – 1983). The estate is situated within La Morra, in the heart of Barolo. Piero began his career in farming and vineyard work and in 1979 decided to dedicate himself entirely to winemaking. The Bosco family vineyards cover a surface area of 5.5 hectares divided between Nebbiolo, Barbera and Dolcetto.
